Introduce your eel to your classmates. Tell them which eel you chose and why.

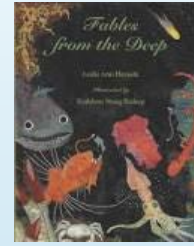

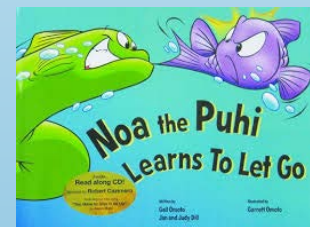
